Have a safe and relaxing week break.

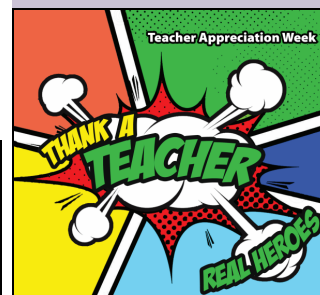

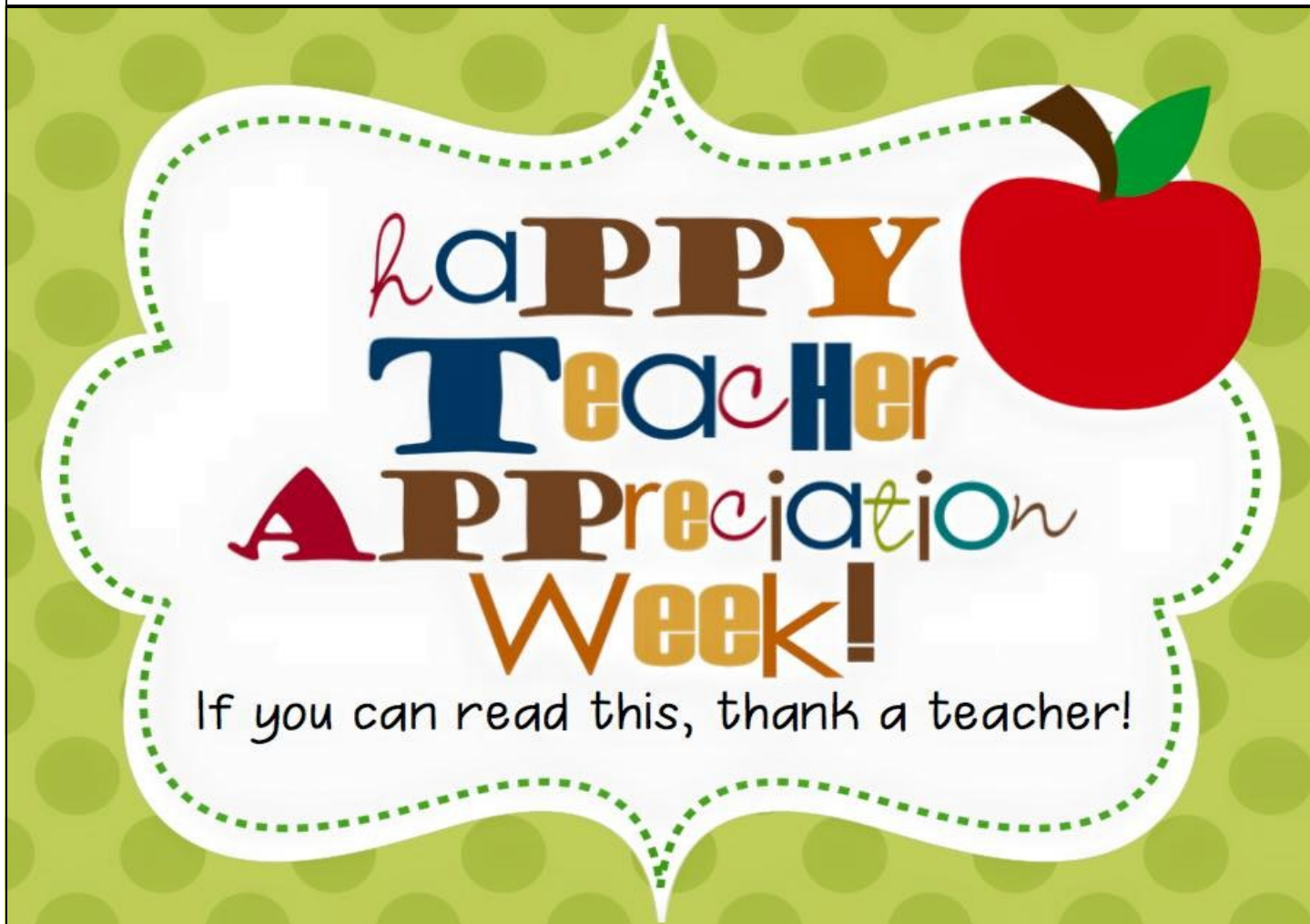
