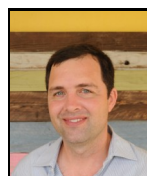

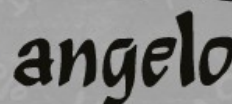
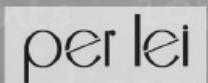
Student Spotlight: Louki Smeets, Annabelle Wittens, Marcello d' Abreu de Paulo
