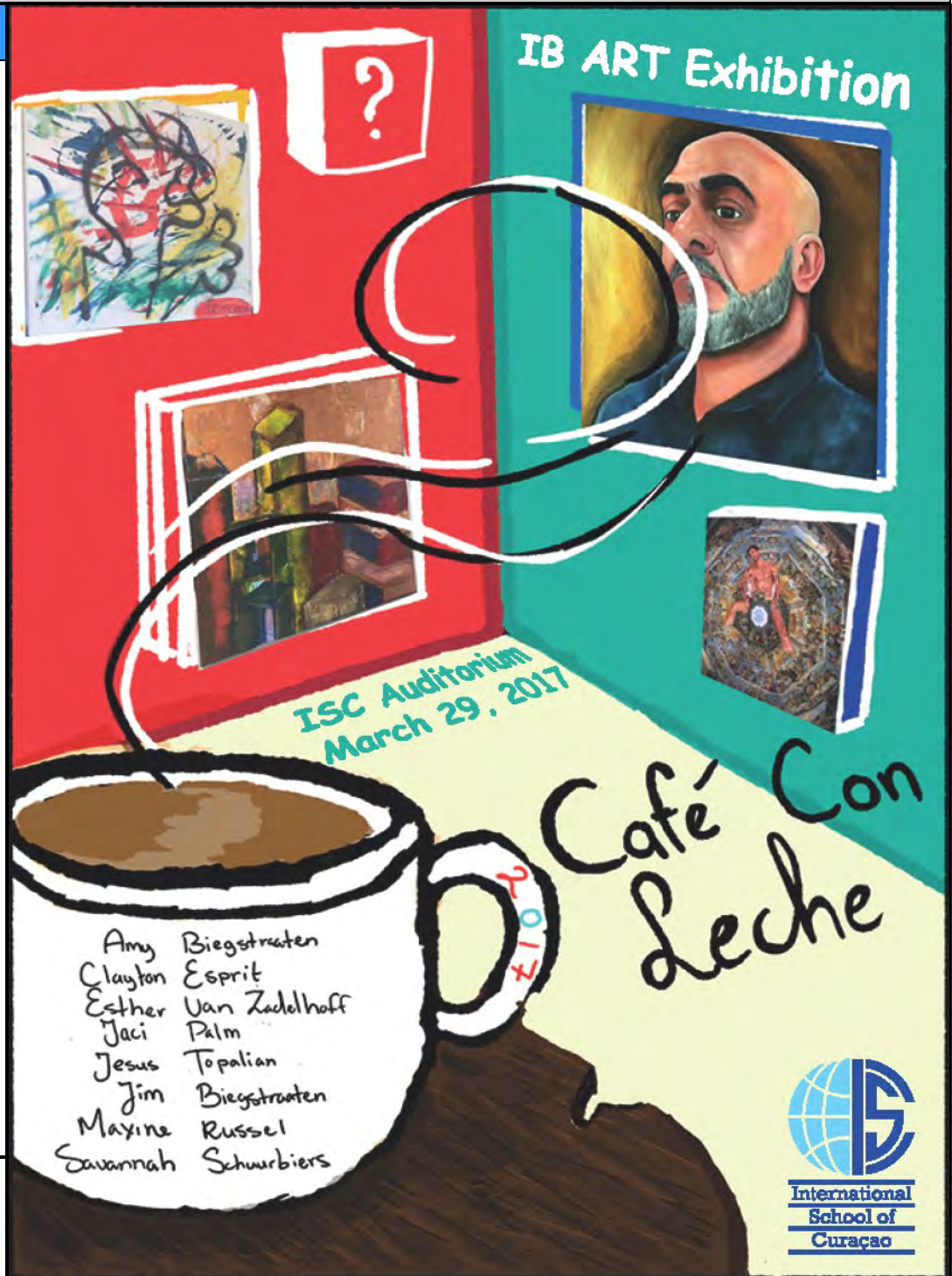
Our Mission: ISC educates students from diverse cultures to have the skills to think creatively, communicate effectively, reason critically, and act compassionately.

Animal Awareness Week

Did you know that April 4th is **World Stray Animals Day**? That is why ISC will organize an **Animal Awareness Week** from March 24th till April 3rd. That event is another great opportunity for our community to show once again, that we are caring, responsible, thoughtful, and helpful.

Unfortunately, there are many animals on our island that do not have a (safe) home. The animal rescue organizations are working hard to help the animals in need but they lack resources (e.g. food, money, and staff). Therefore, we will organize a week filled with fun and educational fundraising activities.

We will launch this great week with an **assembly** with an educational dog demonstration by **I-Animal** (Friday, March 24). There will be a **Helping Paws Fundraiser**, a **Read Aloud** (Monday, March 27), a **Juice and Smoothie Sale** (Tuesday, March 28), a **Jeans Day** (Wednesday, March 29), a **Dog Walk** (Thursday, March 30), and a day to **dress up as your favorite animal** (Wednesday, March 31).

Also, we will have an **Animal Food Collection** (starting on Monday, March 27th), where we will need your help to collect as much cat/dog food (and bowls, collars, blankets, and towels) as possible so we can donate them to the Animal Shelter. GIN students will also collect cat and dog food at Goisco on Saturday and Sunday (April 1-2),

Our GIN students will help throughout the week, and will sell **bandanas** and other products to support I-Animal's education program. With the bandana, you and your dog can join our Dog Walk on Thursday (starts at 5 pm. at Quick 60, Cas Coraweg).

It is going to be a great week where we can lend a hand and **make a difference**. We hope to get all of your support!
