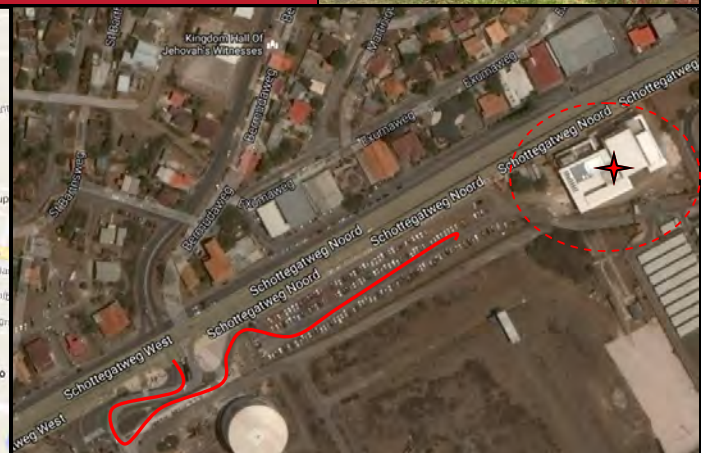
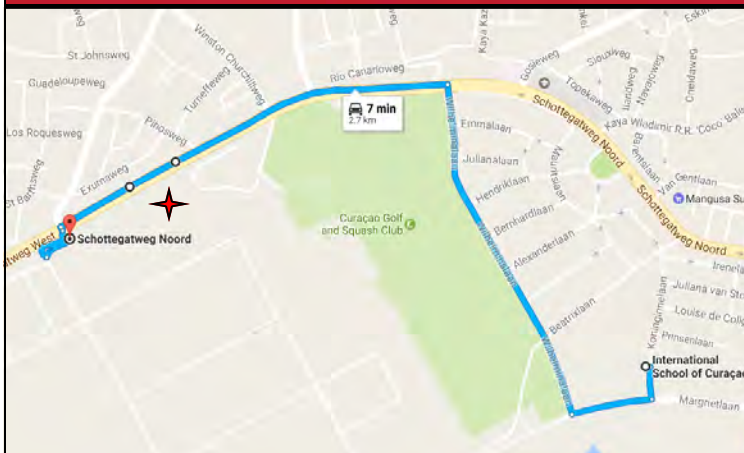

Directions to PWFC Auditorium:

The PWFC auditorium is accessible at the Post 5 entrance to the refinery. Please see the two accompanying maps below. The auditorium is located where the red star is posted. You will need to enter from the main intersection. Once inside, the road circles back— you will not need to go through the security gates— that is specifically for the refinery entrance. Once you begin to circle back, veer right into the parking lot and head down the hill to the auditorium. Please refer to the red line drawn on the image below.

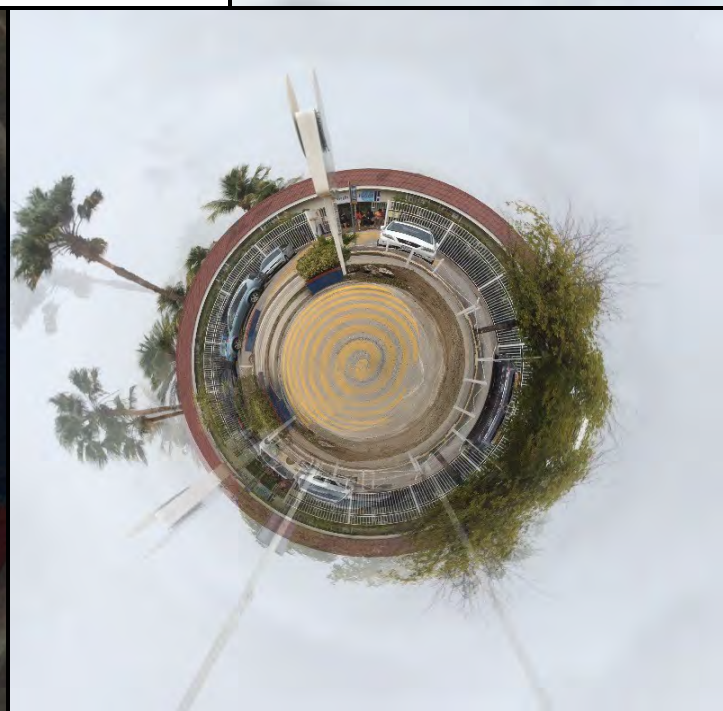

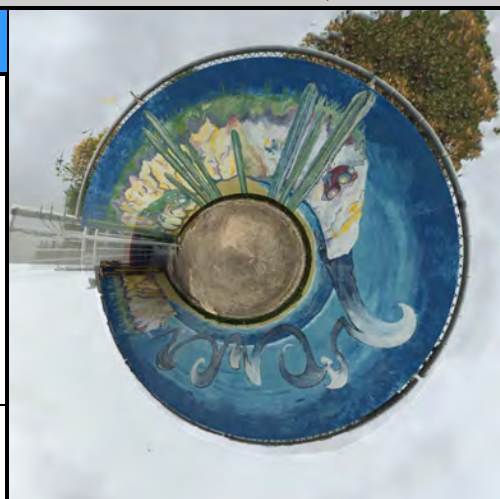

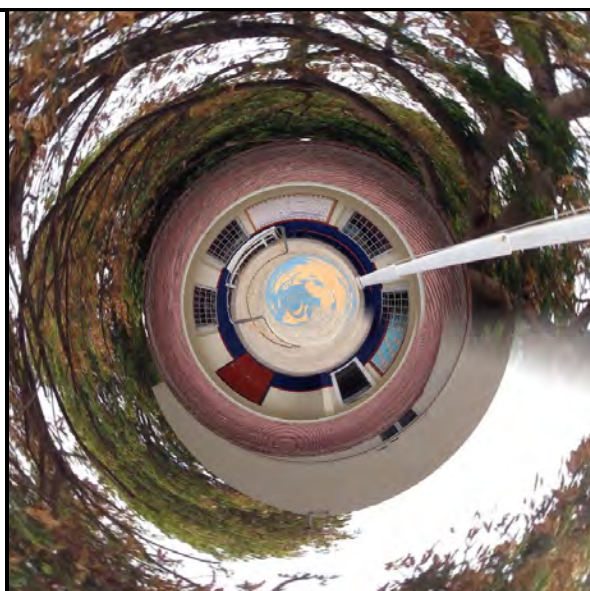

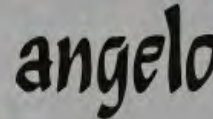
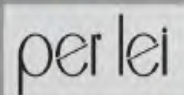
The new testing session for MAP has begun on Monday, May 8th for students in K5 through grade 8. The following link was created as a resource to help your family better understand MAP and your child's results.
