Dear ISC,

We are nearly ready for Friday's U.N. Day celebration. Thank you to all the parents who have volunteered to organize, decorate, and run their country booth. If you are not working in one of the booths, that is ok, but please remember that the success of the event is highly dependent on families bringing in food. As a reminder, here is the statement from the U.N. Day Committee:

*We request each student/parent to bring one to two dozen finger foods representative of his/her country, preferably in a disposable container. Please provide disposable plates, cups and spoons/forks as required for the service of your food item and also ensure that you label your contribution with your complete name and country/region represented. **The food should be delivered between 7:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.** to the receiving station which will be set up in the classrooms: Mendelev Lab or Einstein Lab in the High School.*

Students are encouraged to wear clothes representative of their country. It can be as simple as wearing the colors of your flag, or as elaborate as dressing up in your country's traditional attire. The event is meant to celebrate and embrace our communities diversity, which at the core, is the strength of our school.

Alumni News: Class of 2009 Alumni Tshepho Pietersz

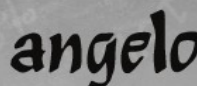
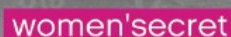
