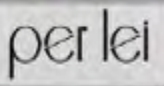
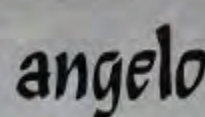
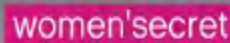
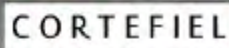
ISC raised over 3,100.00 guilders, which will go directly to helping children, and their families, who are patients at SEHOS.
